GENERAL PROVISIONS

- 1. Eligibility.** All Mississippi law enforcement agencies having primary responsibility for the enforcement of State Statutes and/or County/City Ordinances are eligible for Accreditation.
- 2. Application Fee and Time Limit for Accreditation.** Participating agencies agree to pay an Application Fee as described in the Mississippi Accreditation Manual, and agree to complete all preparation for final on-site assessment within 24 months from the date of enrollment.
- 3. Agency Survey and Department Profile.** These provide information about your agency for MSLEAC Accreditation Assessors.
- 4. Compliance.** Accreditation requires that the Agency adopt and implement policy and procedure documentation and establish operational practices to comply with the Professional Standards endorsed by MSLEAC.
- 5. On-Site Assessment.** An assessment will be conducted by MSLEAC designated professional law enforcement personnel. The Agency will permit and assist access to records and personnel for the purpose of this assessment.
